HALL 100 CLUB

Combe St Nicholas Village Hall Committee needs to raise funds every year for the running of the hall. Money raised is used to maintain and improve the hall for the benefit of all users as well as subsidising local events held at the hall.

By joining the 100 club you can help ensure that YOUR Village Hall remains open as a resource for all the residents in our community, as well as having a chance to win a nice little cash prize every month!

The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all residents of our village and the surrounding area, their family and friends. As a private lottery you have to be invited to join, you will be allocated a number, and your number once allocated is not transferable. **You have to be 16 or over to join.**

Each month there is a draw for 50% of the monthly income. This amount is divided between 3 lucky winners. It works like this:

- For example, if we have 100 members the income for that month will be £100. Half goes to the Village Hall and the other half is the prize fund, split into three:
 - The 1st prize is £25
 - The 2nd prize is £15
 - The third prize is £10
- You pay £12 in advance for 12 months' membership, and are allocated a number unique to you
- You can have as many numbers as you want at £12 each
- The more people who become members, the greater the prize money!

Combe St Nicholas Village Hall 100 Club: Rules of participation

1. The object of the Club is to raise funds for Combe St Nicholas Village Hall.
2. The Club will be run by the Combe St Nicholas Village Hall Committee who will also administer the 100 Club.
3. The Club is open to all residents of our village and the surrounding area, their family and friends.
4. Members must fill in an application form and all members must be 16 or over.
5. Entry will be by subscription of £1 per month per number, paid in advance (£12 per number per annum).
6. Members may have more than one number.
7. New members will be admitted when numbers become available. A waiting list will be kept and numbers will be offered to the first person on the list.
8. The draw will be held monthly at the Village Café Sunday lunch, winners will be contacted personally, and all winners' names will be posted in the Cloverleaf Magazine. If a winner cannot be contacted, the prize will be placed into Combe St Nicholas Village Hall funds after 6 months.
9. The regular monthly prize fund will be 50% of the monthly Income, and there will be three prizes.
10. Registers will be kept recording members, number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
11. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
